

OFFSHORE COMPETENT PERSON

This 16 hour course complies with OSHA 29 CFR 1910 and 1915; USCG NFPA 306 training requirements regarding confined space entry competent person both marine and shipyard operations. Personnel receive a manual and perform practical exercises regarding monitoring and confined space entry and rescue.

9. Role of the Competent Person
10. Examination – Practical hands-on exercise involving monitoring, entry, rescue, lockout/tagout, etc.
