

CONFINED SPACE ENTRY – ENTRANT/ATTENDANT

OSHA 29 CFR 1910.146 requires training for personnel involved in confined space entry. This course is for entrants and attendants. Personnel must have completed a TRS Respiratory Protection training course to enroll in this course. A supervisory course may be given to those in need.

3. Pre-entry procedures – isolation, ventilation, preliminary cleaning precautions, cleaning methods
4. Environmental monitoring
5. Entry procedures – permit process, illumination, solvent use, supervision of work
6. Hot Work operations
7. Preservative coatings
8. Rescue procedures
9. Examination – practical exercise – atmospheric monitoring, confined space entry simulation
